

### ***The Wool Garden Biography:***

From Central Pennsylvania, Candie Falger of Good Shepherd Farm, Terry Kunst of Twin Ponds Fiber Farm, and JaAnn Smith of Knit Picker are partners of The Wool Garden. They collectively have more than 60 years of spinning, weaving, knitting, dyeing, and felting experience. Candie, Terry, and JaAnn each have their own farm/fiber business, and in 2006 they partnered to form The Wool Garden and further share their love of all the fiber arts.

The Wool Garden offers several workshops a year in Central Pennsylvania including Beginning Handspinning, Weaving, and Dyeing. They also attend craft and fiber festivals to sell their own *Original Wool Creations*....handspun yarns, handwoven rugs, scarves, and shawls, handknit hats, and Tibbet Shawls, as well as square knitting needles, and knitting and needle felting kits, patterns, and hand-dyed yarns of Bamboo and Bamboo blends, Merino wool, and Superwash Sock Wool.
