



## **EAGMA Angora Goat Show & Sale**

### **Goat Show Rules**

June 26-27, 2010

#### **Animal Condition/Health:**

1. The exhibitor must own all goats at least 3 months prior to the show.
2. All animals must be shorn on or after 1 January 2010. There can be no combing, washing or treating of show animals' hair.
3. For the protection of your animals, health papers will be checked on arrival of all goats. Each goat must have a certificate of veterinary health inspection issued within 30 days of the show date.

You will need to provide the show chairman with a copy of health papers that will be retained by the fairgrounds.
5. Check-in will be from 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Friday and from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Saturday. No animals may be unloaded without prior inspection of animals and their health certificates. The show committee reserves the right to reject any animal showing signs of health problems.
6. EAGMA assumes no responsibility for accident, damage or loss to animals, persons or property.

#### **Pen Rules:**

1. Health Rules 4, 5 & 6 above also apply to sale animals.
2. Exhibitors shall provide their own water buckets, feed, and bedding. Charge for penning any sale goat is the same, regardless of age.
3. EAGMA makes no guarantee of any kind regarding any animal sales.
4. During the show, trash and manure must be placed in designated areas. Alleyways must be kept clear at all times. Each farm may use an additional pen for storage at no cost. Following the show, all pens are to be cleaned and bedding moved to the designated area.

#### **Fairground Rules:**

1. Please do not bring dogs (unless, of course, they are handicap assistance dogs).

## RED CARD ANGORA GOAT SHOW ENTRY FORM

### Show Classes

The **Red Card** class is for animals that would be disqualified from the white goat competition because of color (faded or pale fleece color, colored faces, ears, legs, horns, etc.) or can not compete in the colored goat competition because of insufficiently colored fleece. Goats that are merely color carriers, but have white fleeces and no visual evidence of color, should be shown in the white competition.
